# 7,000,000

- Since inception, the bulk purchasing distribution program has delivered more than **7 million** pounds of nutritious food to over **25** local food banks.

## COMMISSION ON BEHAVIORAL HEALTH & DRUG PREVENTION

- Lead **six-year campaign** to establish the Florida Prescription Drug Monitoring Program to limit "doctor shopping" for potent opioid medications.

## HURRICANE IRMA

- Partnered with Broward County Public Schools to serve warm meals to **over 4,000 students/families** across the county.
- Worked with FEMA to assist with the assessment and **relocation of over 450 families/individuals** who lost their home.
