PROJECT LIFELINE

Since inception, the bulk purchasing distribution program has delivered more than **14.5 million pounds** of fresh, nutritious food to **over 35 local food banks and feeding programs.**

READINGPALS

Since inception 10 years ago, United Way of Broward County's ReadingPals program has had **more than 1,800 mentors** completing **over 39,000 volunteer hours**, impacting **more than 2,320 children.** More than 88,500 free books have been distributed to ReadingPals students' home libraries.

MICROBUSINESS RECOVERY

United Way of Broward County's Microbusiness Recovery Program offered grants of up to **\$10,000 for qualifying Black- and brown-owned businesses** to help them weather the pandemic. Ultimately, more than 50 businesses were selected, and a total of approximately **\$500,000** was distributed.

CRISIS INTERVENTION TEAM

More than **1,200 individuals**, including law enforcement, Veterans service organizations, corrections officers and Broward County Library systems, received trainings in safe, effective and compassionate response to people experiencing mental health crises.
